God saves us apart from any human works, by grace alone through faith alone, resulting in a life of good works to the glory and praise of God.

Exposition of Ephesians 2:1-10

1. Man's Lost Condition: Summed up in one word - DEAD (1-3)

2. God's Grace: Made ALIVE in Christ (4-6)

3. God's Purpose: To the praise of His Glory and Grace (7-10)

Conclusion

1. Salvation is not man's doing but God's doing - people are saved by grace not by works.
2. People do not enter into eternal life because of their good deeds - but because of God's goodness in Christ.
3. This salvation is God's gift, not compensation for our efforts. This is so that we will not boast but give glory to God for our salvation.
